Release of Interim Result - Management Discussion and Analysis

Operating Revenue: The Group's revenue primarily comes from hotels, ballooning, food, and beverages. Due to the low season (1, April to 30, September 2024), travel and business activity declined, and the ballooning service was suspended. As a result, total revenue fell by 81% compared to the same period last year.

Cost of Sales: The Group's cost of sales for April–September 2024 was 187,442,000 Kyat, down 62% from the same period last year, reflecting strict cost control in key operations.

Other expenses: Including administrative, selling, property maintenance, utilities, and exchange rate differences, totaled 619,844,000 Kyat for (1, April to 30, September) 2024, down 31% from last year. This decline reflects cost-saving measures aimed at optimizing operational efficiency.

Impairment Loss: Amata Resort and Spa – Ngapali, operated by the Group's subsidiary United International Group Limited, conducted an unscheduled impairment test in September 2024, recognizing an impairment loss of 1,338,923,000 Kyat.

Interest Expense: The Group's interest expenses for 1, April to 30, September 2024 totaled 1,484,337,000 Kyat, a 52% increase from last year, driven by higher borrowing interest rates.





<u>Profit(Loss) for the period</u>: For the period from 1 April to 30 September 2024, the Group reported a net loss of 4,063,496,000 Kyat, compared to 1,948,330,000 Kyat in the same period last year. This was mainly due to a significant drop in hotel revenue, temporary hotel closures with fixed costs, and an unscheduled impairment test at Amata Resort and Spa – Ngapali, operated by United International Group Limited.

Financial Condition: The Group's non-current assets decreased by 4.2%, and current assets also decreased by 31.4%. Current liabilities increased by 14%, while non-current liabilities decreased by 14.6%. Total equity, consisting of share capital, retained earnings, and non-controlling interest (NCI), decreased by 33.5% for the interim period ending 30 September 2024 compared to the previous year.

Release of Interim Financial Statement for six months ended 30 September 2024

MADPL reported revenue of MMK 479 million for the period ended 30 September 2024, reflecting a decline from MMK 1.1 billion in the same period last year. Gross profit dropped to MMK 25 million, down from MMK 337 million in the previous year. The company recorded a net loss after tax of MMK 73 million for the period, a sharp downturn from the net profit of MMK 499 million reported in the prior year.
